Silviu Ioan POPA is the Secretary General of the Romanian National Integrity Agency (ANI) since January 2016.

Mr. POPA has a 13 years' experience in the area of corruption prevention, being specialized in financial disclosure systems. Mr. POPA was a short-term expert in several anti-corruption projects with the Council of Europe, European Commission, International Monetary Fund or the World Bank.

Mr. POPA also contributed to several publications on topics concerning methods of reviewing the content of financial disclosures submitted by public officials and conflicts of interests or establishing effective financial disclosures systems.

In his capacity within the National Integrity Agency (ANI), Mr. POPA is responsible with coordinating the implementation of the EU's Cooperation and Verification Mechanism (CVM) objectives, fostering the dialogue with international stakeholders and similar institutions, drafting and implementing institutional and national anti-corruption strategies.

In 2021, Mr. POPA was elected for a three-year mandate as a Member of the Board of Governors – International Anticorruption Academy (IACA).

Mr. POPA graduated the Faculty of Political Sciences, University of Bucharest and he is currently studying for a Master degree in Development, Cooperation and Humanitarian Aid.
